




Word-clouds visually represent word data. Give prominence to words that appear frequently.






















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
Word cloud C) from A Place Called Home




These 3 word clouds respond to the question "what does heritage mean to me"?






With word clouds, the bigger and bolder the word appears, the more often it's mentioned within a given text (or list) and the more important it is.


